INSPECTIONS:

Hazardous waste awaiting shipment or in storage areas must be inspected weekly, looking for leaks and for container deterioration. The inspection log must include the dates and findings of these inspections. Additional items to be checked at the time of the inspections should be included but are not limited to:

- a) Ensure all containers are CLOSED,
- b) Ensure all containers are labeled "HAZARDOUS WASTE"
- c) Ensure all containers are also labeled with a clear descriptive name such as "WASTE PHARMACEUTICALS", "SPENT SOLVENT", or "WASTE PAINT".
- d) Ensure all containers in waste storage include an accumulation start date. Accumulation start date requirements are different for satellite accumulation containers. See MPCA factsheet on labeling and storing hazardous waste - <http://www.pca.state.mn.us/index.php/view-document.html?gid=4033> for more details.
- e) Ensure adequate aisle space is maintained in the storage areas to allow the unobstructed movement of personnel, fire protection equipment, spill control equipment, and that all labels are clearly visible.
