Subject: Township Road and Bridge Aid Qualification Levy
 For Road and Bridge Aid Payable in 2013

A township's road and bridge levy must be at least .04835% of its taxable market value for the preceding taxes payable year in order to qualify for road and bridge aid in the subsequent year.

Following is the calculation of the minimum payable 2012 road and bridge levy for each township in order to qualify for Road and Bridge Aid in 2013:
