THE PARK:

St. Croix Bluffs Regional Park is 579 acres with 3,800 feet of shoreline along the St. Croix River. The park was purchased from the Ceridian Foundation in 1996. The foundation owned and operated the park since 1967 for employees and retirees of Control Data and the Ceridian Corporation.

BOATING:


The St. Croix River is accessible from the park's concrete boat ramp. There are parking spaces for 50 car-trailers. If all the spaces are filled, do not launch your boat until a space opens. There is no overflow parking for boat trailers. The launch is designed for boats up to 19 feet in length.

SWIMMING:

A small swimming beach is open from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day. When the St. Croix River is at flood stage the beach is closed. There are no lifeguards on duty. Coast Guard approved life jackets are the only flotation devices allowed at Washington County beaches. Do not swim outside the buoys or hang on them. Dogs, alcohol and glass containers are not allowed on the beach. Fishing is not allowed in the beach area.

PICNIC PAVILIONS:

The park has two pavilions, Hilltop and Eagle Ridge that may be reserved for group picnics. Call the park office for rates and availability.



NATURE PROGRAMS:

Saturday evening nature programs are offered from Memorial Day through Labor Day Weekend. They begin at 7:15 p.m. at the Nature Program Area in the campground. Check the office for program topics and changes

CAMPGROUND RULES:

- * Unapproved FIREWOOD is BANNED!
- * NO PETS or ALCOHOL allowed.
- * ONE CAMPING UNIT / 8 people per site.
- * ALL VEHICLES, including tent trailers, must park on the gravel PAD. Boat trailers may park on the grass.
- * EXTRA VEHICLES may park at the tennis court or across from Site 18.
- * VISITORS to your site must have a vehicle permit.
- * QUIET HOURS: 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.
- * If the WEATHER SIREN goes off, take shelter in one of the bathroom buildings.
- * CHECKOUT time is 1:00 p.m.
- * RE-REGISTER by 11:00 a.m.
- * FIRES PERMITTED in the fire rings or self contained grills.
- * CUTTING park trees and GATHERING dead firewood is prohibited.
- * The MAXIMUM STAY is 14 days.
- * GATE CLOSES at 10:00 p.m. and OPENS at 6:00 a.m.
A camper's GATE CARD is available at the park office, for a \$10.00 deposit.
- * Parent or guardian MUST accompany campers under 18.
- * FIREWORKS are prohibited.
- * Please alert the Park Office or Camp Host on duty of any problems.
- * DUMPSTATION and DUMPSTERS are located near the campground entrance.
- * SMOKING is not allowed near any beach or playground area.
- * MANAGEMENT reserves the right to ask any camper to leave.

PARK: 6 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

PARK OFFICE:

April - May: 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Memorial Day - Labor Day: 8:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m.

September - March: 8:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

AFTER HOURS:

Check in with CAMP HOST in site A or B.

BOAT LAUNCH:

6:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. No Vehicles or trailers are allowed in the parking lot after 11 pm.

To leave your boat in the water over night, purchase an anchor fee at the park office. Slips are for loading and unloading.
