

Washington County, Minnesota Ordinances

Ordinance No. 10 **An Ordinance Providing for the Filing of Surveys with the County Surveyor.**

Date Approved: 7/14/1975

The Board of County Commissioners of Washington County, Minnesota, Does Ordain:

Section 1.

Any registered land surveyor who shall perform a survey of land located within Washington County for an individual or corporation shall file a true and correct copy of the survey in the Office of the County Surveyor within 30 days after completion of said survey.

Section 2.

The County Surveyor is hereby directed to draw up rules and regulations detailing the manner of said filing and incidents thereto.

Section 3.

All surveys so filed shall be public records and shall be available at all reasonable times for inspection by any person under rules and regulations determined by the County Surveyor.

Section 4.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.

An Act relating to certain counties: providing for the filing of surveys with the county surveyor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1.

389.07 Filing of surveys in certain counties

In any county in which the office of county surveyor is a full time position and the surveyor has an office in a building maintained by the county for county purposes, the county board may by ordinance adopted in accordance with section 375.51 require that any registered land surveyor who shall perform a survey of land for an individual or corporation shall file a true and correct copy of the survey in the office of the county surveyor within 30 days after completion of the survey. The manner of filing, and all incidents there-of, shall be determined by the county surveyor. All surveys so filed shall be public records and shall be available at all reasonable times for inspection by any person.
